Please make sure family members understand all pool rules, and help us keep Bayside Pool a safe environment. Parties & Pool Rentals

Each year the Monday after Spring Break, Pool Manager Ken Ericson begins accepting pool party reservations. Evening parties are limited to Tuesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday only. Morning rentals are on Saturday and Sunday only. Call early as popular dates go fast! Remember that we hold a Moonlight Swim on two Saturdays each month. The price to rent the pool is \$80 for two hours and \$45 for one hour. No rentals are allowed during normal operating hours.

Know Your Membership Number!

Members are reminded to use the check-in system for themselves and guests. It is designed to address concerns about guest policy abuses and lifeguard distractions. Members must identify themselves by name and the membership number found on your spring statement and address label.

Swim Team Registration Time Has Arrived!

Swim team will start on Monday, July 2nd and is open to kids who can swim 50 yards continuously. The swim team season is 7 weeks long this summer and emphasizes a fun, recreational approach to competitive swimming. The cost is \$70 for members (\$65 for multiple swimmers per family) and \$85 for non-members (\$80 for multiple swimmers per family.) SPACE IS LIMITED to only 100 participants this year. Pool members must register by June 15 to guarantee a spot. Please register as soon as possible. Registration forms are available on our Bayside website. There will be a parent meeting and swim party on Thursday, June 28th at 8pm at the pool. Head Coach this year is Paul Hanson. Assistant Coaches are Halee Hyatt and Paige Godfrey. Bayside Membership & Board Information

At the time of this printing, we have had at least a dozen stock sales. This is the largest movement on the waitlist in quite a while. Summer memberships for those who are inactive this year number about 31 at this time. The Board will be considering

methods to shorten the time it takes to become a member over the next year.

Consider paying \$25 to place someone on the Bayside waitlist as a wedding gift. It can be as long as 6 years before you actually become an official member. Our newest members have had to wait for summer membership status each year based on the inactive memberships. Please encourage people to place themselves on the waiting list as soon as possible. Information is available on the website.

Remember! Inactive Members may use the facilities 10 times in a season. This is a limit of **10 usages per membership number, per year.** For example, if 4 family members use the pool during regular operating hours on the first day the pool opens, only 6 usages are left for the entire swimming season. Guest passes may be used to cover the \$3 guest fee. Books of 10 guest passes are available for \$25 from the lifeguard on duty. Inactive members may not rent the pool for parties or use the facilities as guests of active members.

The Board has made several purchases in the past year to replace old equipment, to make repairs when possible, and to put our membership dues to good use. We also know the value of a new coat of paint! Look for new lounge chairs (purchased on sale at the end of the season) and a sound system! Remember to ask a lifeguard to light one of the outdoor heaters when you have a party or you are watching kids at a Moonlight Swim! Steve Nash is the contact person for our ongoing efforts to clean up our adjacent lot. Help is always appreciated.

We expect to use our website more and more as time goes by. If you need copies of the Annual Stockholders' Meeting minutes or the treasurer's report, contact the Pool Manager or any board member.
